



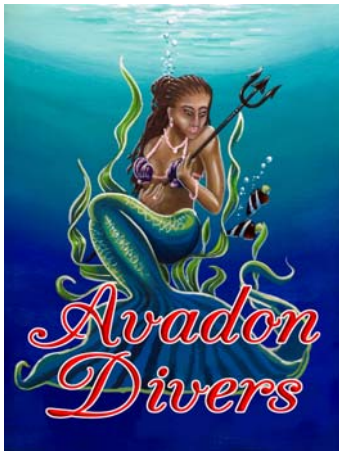

SAILING

SAILING ~ Day sails with snorkeling, sunset cruise, even moonlight sails, can easily be arranged on spacious mono hulls, catamarans or small sailboats.

Day Tripper Catamaran Sailing & Snorkeling: \$66.00USD per person.
Trip leaves at 9:00am and return at 4:00pm.

Day Sail \$132.00USD per person

This day sail excursion takes you out to the inner cayes where you can snorkel for a while when the boat stops to moor off. Kayaks are on board, so if you'd like to kayak around while the boat is moored, you can do that too. Fishing is also offered in the way of trolling while the boat is underway. A full cooked lunch, snacks and refreshments are included. Departure time is 9am. Duration of trip is 6 hours.

Sunset Cruise \$96.00USD per person

Watch the beautiful Belizean sun set in the Maya Mountains as you enjoy a cool late afternoon and evening sail. Wine and hors d'oeuvres are included. Departure time is 4pm. Duration of trip is 3 hours.

GLOVER'S REEF SNORKELING & DIVING

Glover's Reef is approximately 34 miles out from Placencia. It is an atoll, one of the only five in the western hemisphere. Pristine waters with many forms of marine life and corals. One of the best snorkeling you ever experience. It is approximately 2 hours by boat to Glover's Reef. There is approximately 4 ½ hours snorkeling time.

THE GREAT BLUE HOLE SNORKELING & DIVING (Mondays) ~ The Great Blue Hole

is approximately 68 miles out from Placencia and the boat ride is about 3hrs or so. It is the largest ocean sinkhole in the world and is the only blue hole that can be plainly seen from outer space. The Blue Hole is near perfectly circular in shape, more than 1,000 feet across and 480 feet deep.

WHALE SHARK



WHALE SHARK ~ From March to June when the moon is right the gentle giants of the deep, the whale sharks, can often be seen in the Gladden Split Reserve approximately 20 miles off shore, East of Placencia. A cornucopia of aquatic life including snapper, barracuda, sea turtles and dolphin are often members of the incredible underwater ballet that the whale sharks star in. Ideal for both divers and snorkelers who crave an experience like no other.

A typical day starts at between 6 to 8 in morning, and ends at your discretion. During the off tide hours you can take a break from fishing and cool off at the surrounding islands that provide us with shade, or take a nap under a coconut tree. Your fishing package includes a guide, a boat, equipment, a light snack, lunch (in some cases) and refreshments.

FULL DAY OF FISHING - YOUR CHOICE OF THE KIND OF FISHING

23ft Boat - Max 2 persons - \$400.00USD

32ft Boat - Max 8 persons (Take the family and combo fishing with snorkeling and/or beach combing) - \$685.00USD Max of 3 persons fishing at one time.

FLY FISHING

Spend your day working local flats, reefs and outer cays for species like bonefish, the illusive permit, tarpon and barracuda. By wading or from the casting deck of the boat, your guides will create the best opportunity to land your dream fish. Perhaps you can rack up the grand slam of bonefish, permit and tarpon. We will offer good advice as to how to improve your casting skills and your fish-catching ability.

SPIN & BAIT CASTING

Using artificial lures, jigs and live bait we will comb just about any area within and around the barrier reef. We can go anywhere to suit the needs of our anglers while providing them with the availability of a variety of game fish, and is one of the best ways to get non-stop fish catching action all day.

TROLLING INSIDE THE BARRIER REEF

Using light tackle, cut or live bait and artificial lures we go after king fish, jacks, and other varieties of pelagic species. This is an easy and fun way to have an exciting day of fishing.

DEEP SEA FISHING

Artificial lures, rigged ballyhoo and fast trolling techniques are used to try your luck at the chance of getting the great blue marlin, sailfish, dolphin (mahi mahi), and Wahoo on the outside of the barrier reef. This type of fishing makes for long days covering great distance just waiting for the big one.

BOTTOM FISHING

Using hook, line and sinker and a vast variety of local bait we go after snapper, groupers and other bottom dwellers. This is the most productive type of fishing, providing you with non-stop action all day long. In Belize, this method what most traditional fishermen use to catch fish for more than 150 years.

ALL LEVELS OF EXPERIENCE

Spin & Bait Casting, and Trolling Inside the Barrier Reef is recommended for an easy day on the water With a the best chance of coming home with the trophy fish.

ADVANCED

For Fly Fishing it is best if you have some experience, and it is recommend that if you bring you own equipment , please check it by setting it up and taking a few practice cast on the front lawn.

FLY FISHING CHECK LIST:

8 weight fly rod
Good reel with at least 150 yards of backing and floating line

Good selection of flies (tans, olive, pink and white work best)

KAYAKS & CANOES



KAYAKS ~ plenty of time for sea, river or cave kayaking. No previous kayaking experience required.

Half Day Guided Trip: \$85.00USD per person (1-2 pax) \$60.00USD per person (3 or more)

Enjoy peaceful paddling in the unique habitat of the Placencia Lagoon. Here your guide can help you spot various sea birds and, occasionally, manatee and dolphin.

Trips are for (4) hours during either morning or afternoon. Departure times to be arranged.

Full Day Guided Trip: \$170.00USD per person (1-2 pax) \$125.00USD per person (3 or more)

Your guide will take you to an island off-shore of Placencia, or (depending on the weather) possibly boat to the islands and guide you back to Placencia. Your day will be spent paddling crystal clear waters and snorkeling

around various islands. The inner cays, sometimes referred to as 'The Range', offers not only snorkeling along coral patch reefs dotted with colorful fish, but mangrove snorkeling as well. Because these islands don't see a lot of visitors, there is an abundance of marine life. Your maximum paddle time is 4 hours, and your snorkel gear and lunch is included. Departure time - 9:00am

Self Guided Tours: \$40.00USD per day - single or double kayak

For your personal adventure heading up the lagoon, we provide you with a map, tell you about the points of interest, and what to look out for in wildlife. Should you choose to go to the inner cays from the end of the peninsula, you can easily find your way back, as the landmarks are easy to make out. Departure time is on your time, just be back before sunset.

ADVENTURE CANOEING ~ on your jungle adventure down the scenic Monkey River you will encounter gentle rapids moving along a lush jungle river keeping a weather eye out for crocodiles, green iguanas, a menagerie of birds and of course Howler Monkeys.

JUNGLE WALK



MONKEY RIVER ~ Imagine yourself moving along a lush jungle river keeping a weather eye out for crocodiles, green iguanas, a menagerie of birds and of course Howler Monkeys. A trip to Monkey River is all that and more - exploration up the river and then into the jungle, a true Belizean lunch in the sleepy village nestled at the mouth of the quick moving river and an exhilarating boat ride between here and there through a mangrove maze - home to the gentle yet often elusive manatee. This is a great trip for the nature lovers in us all.

Locally known as the Jaguar Reserve, you'll find great jungle trails for hiking adorned with medicinal plants, natural water slides, pristine waterfalls, and a cool river for tubing. A bird watchers' heaven, this is the home to Belize's largest cat, the elusive jaguar and as the saying goes "You probably won't see him, but he'll certainly see you."

ZIP LINE / CAVE TUBING

CANOPY TOUR OR ZIP LINE ~ The Canopy Tour is the same as Zip Line. Our Aerial Trek Canopy Tour offers adventurous guests a thrilling opportunity to soar through the jungle treetops high above the forest floor. The canopy tour involves traversing from one platform to another along a steel cable suspended up to 80 feet above the forest floor. All tours are escorted through the forest canopy by a lead guide and a follow guide to ensure your safety. Your tour will take you over six platforms. The tour will take approximately 1 hour.

MAYA RUINS & CAVE

XUNANTUNICH RUIN & INLAND BLUE HOLE ~ trod where the ancient Maya once did. Xunantunich, Belize's largest & most excavated major centers of the Mayan world. Xunantunich is located atop a ridge above the Mopan River, within sights of the Guatemala border and Melchor, Guatemala. The core of Xunantunich occupies about one square mile (2.6 km²), consisting of a series of six plazas. Refresh at Inland Blue Hole for a short swim.

NIM LI PUNIT & BLUE CREEK CAVE ~ trod where the ancient Maya once did. The late classic ceremonial site of Nim Li Punit, famous for its stela. Afternoon swim in cave.

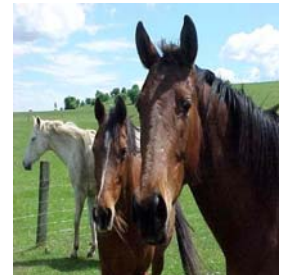
HORSEBACK RIDING
